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nothing. If your military...it's not mine. You're at war; I'm not. If your military had paid attention and reckoned up the cost, it would have realized that these are not street thugs. They're not going to be intimidated by this massive show of kill power. And before you run those young men and women in there, you better be aware of where you're sending them. But they didn't care. And saying these are street thugs does not change a thing. They had been told in this country that all of those cities in south Iraq had been captured. You know what the latest word is now, because of the prodding of the foreign media? None of those areas have been pacified, none of them. But that's not the story they told. And one of the generals said, they keep secret the casualties being inflicted on America. People like me are condemned. People like me are the ones who try to hold to account those who are so quick to cheerfully send other people's children into harm's way. No interest of this country is at risk based on anything that Iraq could do. There are diplomats in this country, there were generals in the Pentagon, who were counseling against sending those young people to war. And it would be very easy for me to stay way over here in Nebraska, safe from everything, and say, it's great what they're doing; send more of them over there. And by the way, they are preparing to send 100,000 more young American people to Iraq; 100,000 more. This country cannot even acknowledge that they miscalculated and underestimated. Then why send the 100,000 now, who have to try to participate in the battle, when the intent for them was to go there and stabilize everything after Baghdad had fallen and Saddam Hussein had been killed? This country deals in insanity and craziness. And I will never feel obliged to agree with everything somebody does just because they come from the same continent on which I live, or because they say they're Americans, or they're politicians, or they're generals. Not one general, Senator Friend, has died. Not one colonel has died. Not one captain, except the one in a tent,...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and his death was from an American soldier.
