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There have been a whole number of meetings on this that both senators and staff have spent an enormous amount of time on it. And at least as of this moment in time, all that has come to naught, in terms of improving the green copy of the bill. But I hope that doesn't mean that there's not some compromise forthcoming before Select File. The administration is opposed to the amendments and to going beyond the green copy, as I understand it. I think that represents bad public policy. I think we need to do a lot more in the service area...service contract area in order to bring that area up to the level that we require for the contract of goods and materials. Traditionally, we've understood that process very well. It happens to be a very centralized process. That doesn't mean that services contracts have to be just as centralized. But it does mean that there's a body of expertise relating to contracts of all types that resides in the materials division. And we're not making use of that expertise and applying it to the services contract area. That's one of the major problems and differences here. So I sincerely hope that we can get...move along a little faster on this. I think there are additional things that can be done that would make a lot of sense to all of you. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, I'm not sure of the characterization as to whether we have an agreement or not. The appearance of a representative of the administration in my office this morning would make me think that there wasn't an agreement. I did...it sounded to me as if there was some elements of agreement. What I'd like to have happen is...and I'll defer to either Senator Preister or Senator Schimek. Perhaps Senator Preister is the right person. I'll give you the rest of my time. Here's what I'm interested in knowing, Don. Person in my office this morning from the administration, I think they were saying, essentially, they liked the green copy of the bill as it originally was. There was a committee amendment that they didn't like. I knew that much. I didn't understand from that communication that there was an agreed upon set of amendments now. What's our current status with respect to an agreement between you and the administration on a body of amendments? Do we have a deal or
