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of the service contracts. And the other thing that the white copy does...and I'm sure both of these things, in some way, we're going to want to include in that green copy, or the bill that moves on to Final. It no longer required a central repository. And DAS told us that that could be a very expensive and difficult situation just for storage purposes and all of that. So what we agreed was that the agencies themselves, if they so chose, could keep those contracts, but that there would have to be some kind of referral to it in the computer system, so everybody would know where that contract was housed. And that was going to also help the fiscal note. So there are some things in the white copy that we haven't even really spent much time on that are going to be useful to add to the green copy on Select File. But at this point, I think it would be easier for us to come back on Select File with that new amendment that everybody can buy onto.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: So with that, Mr. President,...I'm looking over my little list, and I guess that's all I need to say at this point. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I, too, want to compliment Senator Preister and Senator Schimek and others that have been working on this bill. I guess I'm one of those that does also have some concerns on Section 7 on who's going to be exempt. I have a question about the Investment Council. I did visit with Senator Preister, and we're not sure where that might also fit in. I do agree that we need to do something. I just want to make sure that the something that we do is valuable, and that we are really solving the problems that we've been looking at as far as service contracts. I do have a concern that we don't make this a very lengthy project. And I had some of those concerns looking at the white copy of the amendment. So with that, I will be voting to defeat the committee amendments, and really hope that we can work together in getting the bill moved forward. Thank you.
