SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...alias because I don't try to track the person down. Phone calls, I tell Cindy who works in my office, you don't have to listen to that stuff. I'm the elected official. You don't even have to deal with it, just hang up. I don't have one of those panic buttons which you're supposed to punch in your office if somebody comes in and you're afraid of them. When I'm walking down the hallways of the Capitol Building and I hear footsteps behind me, I don't turn around or walk close to the wall. What we need to do is try by our example to stop the citizens of Nebraska from being so timorous, so fearful and afraid of everything. This is one of those situation, Senator Mossey, where people have nothing to fear but fear itself. And a gun in the hands of a frightened person is a terrible deadly mix. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Dwite Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature. Through my eleven years that I've been in the Legislature, I've always signed onto this bill. I owned handguns before I was 21. Guns are something that I've always enjoyed and guns are something that I think I have a right to carry, whether that be a handgun, a long gun, or a powder gun. I'm with Senator Tyson, this is not going to add more guns to the streets because them guns are already there. We've got one of the biggest outfitters in the country in Nebraska, and they sell a lot of guns, and a big percentage of them are handguns, Cabela's. There is a gun shop in Omaha, Guns Unlimited, that I love to go to and just walk around and window-shop, per se, because I can't afford a lot of the guns in there. People don't see me as a gun carrier. I belong to two different gun clubs. Can you carry concealed? As Senator Tyson said, they aren't going to charge you if you've got a reason for carrying. And I want to go back to what Senator Smith, this is training.
