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arms. And I have a person up in my district says, well, why do you have to do anything to be able to pass this to carry concealed weapon? Well, you can carry it in the open right now. But if actually you want to carry it concealed, that's when you got to have a change in our statutes. So that's the reason for the bill. And I think I want to give the Judiciary Committee a lot of credit for putting all the rules and regs in this, because I think they are important because we're talking about something here that we can have for here on out. And we realize a lot of other states have got it, and crime has actually went down in other states that's passed this. So I think it's really important. I think another thing that people don't realize, there's a lot of 4-H projects right now that's got gun clubs. And my grandson is in it right now, working with the BB guns right now. And I think that's real important for the safety of guns. And a lot of people don't realize it, but if you grow up with guns, it's a lot safer than if you don't have them in the home at all. So I think we should think about that. And the federal law that we passed here awhile back saying that you can't have any guns on school grounds, that's when I started to get a lot of phone calls from my district, because a lot of the kids there had them on their...in their pickups, on the racks, and they hunted pheasants on the way to town, to school, and on the way home. And all of a sudden, they park in the schoolyard, it would be against the federal law. So my phone really started ringing from my area, I know that, because everybody wanted to pack a gun in their pickup going back and forth because there are a lot of...in the area up there where I'm at, there's a lot of coyotes right now. In fact, I lost a calf just yesterday morning from a bunch of coyotes cornered it. And they always want to have a gun ready to be able to help save something like that. So the guns is a mainstay in my district, and they keep asking me, when are you going to get something passed so that we can carry a concealed weapon? And a lot of people say, well, you'll have a lot more guns out. I don't believe you will. The people that got guns now is the ones that's going to ask for the permits. They're not going to go buy a gun just to get a permit. I think that's something that you got to realize. But with that, I would stand in support of the bill. And as far as this committee amendment here we have right now, the carrier enforcement are a part of the State Patrol now. I don't know if
