SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...strongest will. Thank you, Mr. President. I'll...

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on FA1224 to FA1212 to LB 265. The question before the body is, shall the amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of FA1224. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the committee amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: FA1224 has been adopted. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend the committee amendment, Mr. President. (FA1225, Legislative Journal page 1116.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment to the committee amendment, component one.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment will go to page 13. Since I just put it on the desk, there's been no opportunity to put it on the gadget or to make a copy and hand it around. But if you want to follow me, you would turn to page 13. And I would start in line 14, which, in your white copy, would be Section 17. I'm going to read that section, because it's only one sentence long. "The Nebraska State Patrol may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of the Concealed Handgun Permit Act." I would like to ask Senator Tyson a question.
