SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the opening on FA1225 to the first component of the divided committee amendment. Open for discussion on that amendment. Senator Thompson.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I believe that I do support this floor amendment. But I want to make sure that I'm understanding it. So I'd like to ask Senator Tyson a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR TYSON: Yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: If the State Patrol...I realize what Senator Chambers...throughout the bill...the amendment, there are references to things that the State Patrol shall do, and then there's this...

SENATOR TYSON: That's correct.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...other one that says they may adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions.

SENATOR TYSON: That's correct.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So for example, the section that deals with what sheriffs have to do, if the State Patrol had to issue rules and regulations, it could cover that. Currently, there aren't any regulations, other than the wording here. Would...am I reading that correctly?

SENATOR TYSON: Well, it's stated what the duties of the sheriff are.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Right. But you could...if the State Patrol had the ability to adopt rules and regulations and...
