SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. Thank you. Mr. President and members, I rise in support of the Chambers amendment. I do think it brings consistency to the bill. And Senator Chambers, I doubt if Senator Tyson would oppose this amendment. But I think I'll ask him here in a minute. But what I would like to do is also ask Senator Tyson about the fiscal note on the bill, because it's...I'm not sure that I am clear on what the fiscal note really does, even after the exchange between Senator Stuthman and Senator Tyson. So if I could, Mr. President, I'd like to ask Senator Tyson a question or two.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR TYSON: Certainly.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Tyson, I realize that the fiscal note on this bill...oh, by the way, are you going to support Senator Chambers' amendment?

SENATOR TYSON: No, I'm not.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: You're not?

SENATOR TYSON: No.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Oh. Okay.

SENATOR TYSON: My light is on, Senator Schimek,...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. And you'll explain.

SENATOR TYSON: ...and I'll give my reasons for it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. But back to the fiscal note, this was written in February,...

SENATOR TYSON: Yes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...on the 4th of February. And I'm assuming it's somewhat out of date now.
