SENATOR TYSON: That's true, and I don't know the basis of that. But I do know what the State Patrol told me, was the cost of an NCIC check. Now, there's two checks involved.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right. I understand that.

SENATOR TYSON: One is the NCIC check, and they tell me that the current price is \$23. That's what the FBI charges the Nebraska State Patrol.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right.

SENATOR TYSON: For a local check, that is to say, a check within the state, they tell me that the cost is \$10. It is for this reason that the \$60 in the green copy went to \$100 in the amended copy. And it is written, if you will notice, in the body of the amendment, that they are to credit the actual cost to the State Patrol cash fund. And the balance goes to the General Fund. The reason that it is...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR TYSON: ...not put there in firm dollars is because the FBI price and the local price may go up.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: So you...what you're telling me is, you think that the difference between the expenditures and the revenues that are suggested in this original fiscal note are going to...that amount is going to decrease? Is that what you're suggesting to me?

SENATOR TYSON: I...well, I believe that they have picked a number of potential licensees.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right.

SENATOR TYSON: I believe that they have...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: They have to do that. I mean, they have to give us a guesstimate, yes.
