and intentionally misleading, because information that is not technically false can still be misleading. So those are things that I think we ought to be looking at in this bill, but we haven't reached the division yet where that is one of the things to be considered. But I have been drafting amendments to address these portions. Now, will the body have an interest in making changes in the bill? I seriously doubt it, but I'm nevertheless going to make these offerings...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and explain why I think they're valid. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion, Senator Thompson. This will be your third time, Senator.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you. Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I again support this floor amendment of Senator Chambers' and I again raise the concern about the sheriffs having the responsibility of issuing these permits and making these determinations that are vague in the law. And the questions...it's been mentioned how many other states have concealed carry, and I'm going to just read to you from a number of those states some incidents that happened with people carrying concealed weapons. This one is from Arizona. On January 30, 1999, a festive day at a Phoenix, Arizona, golf...a Phoenix, Arizona, golf tournament turned scary when Brian Murphy, an Arizona concealed carrier weapons permit holder...carry weapons permit holder, was arrested after scuffling with police. According to police, an intoxicated Murphy began heckling golf superstar Tiger Woods on the sixth hole of the Phoenix Open. Police officer Robert Rucker said he told Murphy to be quiet and he said, I've got a gun too, and squared off on me. After tackling Murphy, police found a semiautomatic pistol in his fanny pack. Tiger Woods noted it was the second time armed fans had gotten into a golf course while he was playing.
