SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Oh, is it Brashear or Tyson? I just need to know.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Tyson, would you answer a question?

SENATOR TYSON: Well, I'd rather have Senator Brashear answer it. But if I must, I must.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. I, again, support the floor amendment that's before us, but I have a question about when a permit holder's license is revoked, how that process is going to work in Nebraska, because it is different in some states. And on page 12, it says if a permit holder violates these subsections, they are guilty of a Class I misdemeanor, and then it moves on and says they will be subject to revocation. So is a violation an arrest or a conviction?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Tyson, would you answer?

SENATOR TYSON: Would you give me your question again?

SENATOR THOMPSON: If a person is arrested,...

SENATOR TYSON: Yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...is their license automatically revoked or do they have to be convicted?

SENATOR TYSON: Oh, they would have to be convicted. Arresting is just a part of a process to determine whether you are innocent or guilty of something.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay.

SENATOR TYSON: Lots of people are arrested and...
