SENATOR HARTNETT:    One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    ...other than the Legislature.    So this amendment that I'm offering, very modest and very reasonable, I hope you will adopt it.    And, Mr. President, I will ask for a call of the house.    Thank you.

SENATOR HARTNETT:    There is a call of the house.    All in favor...do I see five hands?    I believe that's first.    Don't need five hands...five hands for a call.    A call of the house, please.    Will you please check in for a call of the house.    A vote for a call of the house.    All in favor say...vote aye.    Would you please vote, please?    Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR HARTNETT:    The house is under call.    Members, please return to your seats.    Senator Janssen, would you check in, please.    Senator Bromm, Senator Mossey, Don Pederson, Senator Schrock, Senator Brown, Senator Landis, Senator Burling, Senator Kruse, Senator Kremer, Senator Stuthman.    Senator Don Pederson, Senator Stuthman, would you please report to the Chamber.    Senator Stuthman.    Senator Chambers, we are not able to recog...or find Senator Stuthman.    Do you want to go ahead?    Do you want a roll call vote or just a machine vote?    Voting on Senator Chambers' amendment.    All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.    Have you all voted?    Please record.

CLERK:    13 ayes, 25 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR HARTNETT:    The amendment failed.

CLERK:    Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the committee amendments, this component of the committee amendments, with FA1226.
