CLERK: On page 1, line 4, 6, and 8, strike Concealed Handgun Permit and...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I want to withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: Senator Chambers, I now have FA1227; page 1 in line 18, strike "sixteen" and insert "eight." (Legislative Journal page 1121.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I'm with you now. I know because I have several things here. Members of the Legislature, this is a serious amendment. Senator Mines touched on it, the issue, and Senator Tyson yesterday,...

SENATOR HARTNETT: I raise the call.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and the way Senator Friend is looking, he's about to say he'll call the raise. But at any rate, Senator Tyson had mentioned this barrel length at 16 inches, and I had talked about this Buntline Special and wondered how you would conceal a weapon of this kind. So what I am doing with this amendment or attempting to do is to shrink the length of that barrel from 16 inches to 8. I'd like to ask Senator Tyson a question if he is...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Tyson, would you...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...available to answer.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...answer a question? Senator Tyson, would you answer a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR TYSON: Is this to call the question, Senator?

SENATOR HARTNETT: No.

SENATOR TYSON: Oh.

SENATOR HARTNETT: It is not.
