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be held and fired by the use of a single hand." That language has a direct bearing on the item to be defined, which is handgun. There need not be any reference to barrel length. Any weapon designed to be fired and held with one hand would be a handgun. Now that I've made clear what I intend, I would like to ask Senator...oh, Senator Tyson escaped while I was explaining what I was intending to ask him.

SENATOR HARTNETT: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What I will not do is proceed with the amendment to reduce the length of the barrel, but I would like to discuss this definition with Senator Tyson. So the next time I'm recognized, I would like to ask Senator Tyson some questions if he's available.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Thank you, Senator Chambers. I think we have a priority motion from Senator Janssen that we recess until 1:30. All in favor say aye. Ayes have it. We are recessed until 1:30.
