SENATOR TYSON: First of all, Mr. Speaker, I would like to have a call of the house, and I would like to have a roll call vote in regular order.

SPEAKER BROMM: A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of a call of the house please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please report to your seats and record your presence. The house is under call. Unauthorized personnel are requested to leave the floor. Senator Engel, Senator Kruse, Senator Byars, Senator Synowalecki, Senator Preister. Senator Preister, Senator Engel. Senator Preister. Mr. Clerk, a roll call vote, I believe regular order, was requested. And this is the cloture vote, which requires 33 votes.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1122.) 33 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke cloture.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is successful. The next vote is on FA1227. And we'll proceed to vote. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 30 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. Members, we will now proceed to vote on the committee amendment, in undivided form, the original committee amendment. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. And a roll call vote has been requested. Proceed to call the roll, Mr. Clerk.
