SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 46A does advance. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: LB 439A by Senator Hudkins. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hudkins, you're recognized to open on advancement of LB 439A.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. This LB 439 is the Capitol security bill. And this...all this does is just transfers the money from the Department of Administrative Services to the Nebraska State Patrol. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Anybody wishing to speak to the motion to advance LB 439A? Seeing no lights on, Senator Hudkins, did you wish to close? She waives that opportunity. The question before the body is advancement of LB 439A to E & R Initial. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The motion before the body is advancement of LB 439A. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 439A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to advance was successful. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: LB 667A by Senator Jensen. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, you're recognized to open on LB 667A.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. LB 667A is an appropriation of \$15,000 from the Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure cash fund. And should...this is for the Parkinson's Disease Registry. These are cash funds. There is no General Fund expense. When the cash funds stop, actually, the Parkinson's Disease Registry will end. That's all it is, is \$15,000 cash
