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not covering any agricultural hired persons...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...that it basically changes the rules that we've been operating under for an extended period of time. I want to go back and talk again about the case that brought this all about, which was a feedlot case. And we talked a little bit about the facts last time. And what the district court says was that the feedlot operation was a commercial operation, separate and distinct from farming and ranching. The sheer size of the operation shows that it is more in the nature of a commercial enterprise rather than that of an old-fashioned farm or ranch operation. Employers operating businesses performing commercial services primarily for others,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...even though the task performed may commonly occur on a farm or ranch, do not employ farm or ranch laborers as defined in the amend...as defined in the law.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Mr. Clerk, announcement?
