CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber, the house is under call. Senator Bromm, for what purpose do you rise?

SPEAKER BROMM: I'd request a roll call vote, regular order.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may. The house is under call. Senator Jones, Senator Friend, please check in. Senator Quandahl, would you please check in. Senator Chambers, would you check in, please. I thank you. Senator Beutler, Senator Quandahl. The house is under call. Senator Jones. Senator Jones, Senator Quandahl, the house is under call. Senator Jones. I'm sorry, Senator, I did not see you walk in. Sorry to startle you. It takes more than that, I know. Senator Quandahl. All members present or accounted for. I guess all members are present. There's been a request for a roll call vote in regular order. The question before the body is adoption of FA1258, the first component of the divided question to LR 11CA. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1140.) 18 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful. I do raise the call. We are now on the second component of the divided question. That would be lines 11 through 15. (FA1259, Legislative Journal page 1140.) We will continue with the debate. A lot of lights are on. Senator Janssen. Senator Janssen waives. Senator Schimek. She waives off. Senator Bromm. Senator Bromm waives. Senator Beutler.
