Pederson's component of the amendment. If you reduce the number of casinos, obviously, those who are against putting something on the ballot, reduce it to four, you lose the racetrack people totally. And so I guess if we don't...I don't know how we're going to get the 30 votes. This was a couple of ideas that we thought might have some merit, but I'm not going to be able to support this because now it's a one-legged stool, and that usually tips over. So I will vote no, but you can vote however you wish. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Pederson, were you finished, Senator Pederson, also? He waives the rest of his time. The question before the body is adoption of FA1259, the second component of the divided question to LR 11CA. All in favor of FA1259 vote aye, and opposed nay. Voting on adoption of FA1259 offered by Senator Don Pederson. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 22 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful.

CLERK: Senator Janssen would move to amend the bill, AM1107. (Legislative Journal page 1141.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen, you're recognized to open on your amendment, AM1107, to LR 11CA. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. This amendment is intended to be a technical amendment and it's written to the E & R amendments. It does not change the intent of the bill. First, it addresses the issue of the pending petition by amending two provisions of the resolution. In the definition of gaming, it strikes "or a machine" and inserts "a player-activated electronic gaming device, or a player-activated mechanical gaming device." The petition specifically addresses gaming conducted with player-activated electronic gaming devices. It adds the language at the end of 5(c) stating that "The proceeds of the gaming authorized under this subdivision shall be used for such purposes as are determined by the
