two-thirds majority vote of the board of directors that's going to take our legislative action and then make a major policy decision based upon. If we're granting that authority, I think we need to put some responsibility with that authority.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR PREISTER: Authority and responsibility should always go together, and in this case I think it's a minimal amount of authority. If I could ask Senator Schrock a question, please, in my remaining time.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Senator Schrock. On the vote to advise the Legislature, to recommend to the Legislature, that we pass this indemnification in the total package, we were told that that was a unanimous vote, a unanimous vote by the board.
