SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 688 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion before the body is advance LB 688 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The ayes have it. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 619. Senator Mossey, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7082, Legislative Journal page 855.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 619.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion before the body is adopt the E & R amendments to LB 619. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Schrock would move to amend with AM1017. (Legislative Journal page 1051.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open on AM1017 to LB 619. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the purpose of this amendment is to prohibit transfers of water from areas that are not under water restrictions, such as a temporary suspension of water well drilling and closing of areas to the issuance of additional well permits to areas that are under water restrictions. Now let me explain that to you. A year ago we had one NRD that was under a well moratorium. At the present time, we have five NRDs that have a portion or all of their area under new well moratoriums. I'm concerned that people will want to drill wells outside of the moratorium area and transfer the water into the moratorium area. Now that necessarily is not
