SENATOR BROWN: Is this the one that deals with...I couldn't get it up quickly enough on my screen. Is this the one that deals with the 1999 draft of the...yes. In Section 2 it talks about the standards as of July 1999.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. Yes.

SENATOR BROWN: Do you know when...there's a new set of standards that's out for exposure and I wondered if you had any sense of when those standards might go into effect.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No, I do not, but maybe Senator Schimek would. I don't know. Do you have any in the committee, your committee?

SENATOR BROWN: Well, my concern is, are we going to have any problems if we have spelled out statutorily the standards and, if they change, will we need to then come back and...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I cannot honestly answer that. I don't know. This was brought so we had the standards established. If there's new ones, I am not aware of those details.

SENATOR BROWN: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Schimek, do you have anything to add to this at this point? I would ask Senator Schimek to reply, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I do have something to add but I don't know if it's very helpful.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The information that we have is that it could be this year or it could be next year. There is no definite time line on it. So that's not helpful, but that's, I believe, correct information.
