SENATOR KREMER: Yes.

SENATOR McDONALD: ...01, can you tell me, I wasn't able to find that in the original green copy, is it in there?

SENATOR KREMER: I can't tell you that. That's the statutes as they exist today.

SENATOR McDONALD: And I see that we're revising those state statutes in the committee amendment. So has there been a public hearing on that state statute that's been changed in the white copy when I don't find it in the green copy?

SENATOR KREMER: The public hearing was open to anyone to come at whatever they wanted to on the zoning requirements, which are these statutes.

SENATOR McDONALD: But I don't list that state statute in the green copy.

SENATOR KREMER: I don't have it before me now so I can't answer that.

SENATOR McDONALD: And that's my concern. I think we're changing a state statute in the committee amendment that's not originally in the green copy and, because it wasn't originally in the green copy, there was no public testimony on that state statute, and for that reason alone I think that we need to defeat this bill. And after that, I'll turn the time back to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator McDonald. Senator Bromm.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you very much, Mr. President. Let me try to address some of the comments. I was going to address Senator Janssen's questions, but I think Senator McDonald's points are fresh on my mind so I'm going to do that. When we drafted the bill, Senator McDonald, we had in mind making a change to Chapter 23, and you'll see the word "zoning" in the green copy in that section in Chapter 54.
