SPEAKER BROMM:        Thank you, Mr. President. The amendment does two things. And one, it's a clarification of the section which requests that if a final determination is asked for in granting the permit, that that can be either of the county board or the planning commission, since many counties have the county board making the decision on the issuance of a permit. The second thing it does is it removes the emergency clause, so that the bill would come into effect only in the normal course of events, and not immediately. I think there's no reason for that. If we have the law passed, there can be some time for people to decide what they want to do in response, and for the Department of Ag to get ready for the implementation. So I'd ask for your support. Whether you have questions about the underlying bill or not, I would hope that you would be able to support the amendment without question. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    You've heard the closing on AM1188 to the committee amendments. The question before the body is, shall the amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of the amendment by Senator Bromm, AM1188, to the committee amendment to LB 754. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
