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SENATOR BURLING: Because there's no central criteria. There's no...nothing based...to base it on except their own determination. So it wouldn't mean anything to anybody.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you think this will mean something to somebody if it comes from the Department of Agriculture?

SENATOR BURLING: I believe so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So if the Department of Agriculture were to send out a notice to the world that Nebraska's a good place to come and do all these things, that will carry weight and the whole world will beat a path to Nebraska's doorstep. Is that true?

SENATOR BURLING: I'm sure. I'm sure it is. Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That tells us how much (laugh) confidence we ought to put in what you say. Thank you, Senator Burling. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on FA1264. The question before the body is, should that amendment be adopted to the committee amendments? There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.
