SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Bourne, there are no further lights on. You're recognized to close on your amendment, AM1193, to LB 513, if you wish to

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President. Just to reiterate what the amendment does. The bill requires the postsecondary educational institution to provide detailed information regarding the vaccine. And all my amendment does is say that the detailed information shall include information on how a student who couldn't otherwise afford this vaccine can get the vaccine paid for. That's all it does, and I'd appreciate your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. You've heard the closing on AM1193, which is an amendment to LB 513. All those wishing to vote yes, vote yes; vote no, vote no. We're voting on AM1193 to LB 513. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Bourne's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to adopt was successful. Back to discussion of the bill itself. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I had mentioned before to Senator Byars that I was working my way up to a point that I hadn't arrived at through my questioning. And I still haven't gotten there yet, and I'm not going to get there with the first question. Senator Byars, would you look at your copy of the bill, if you have it in front of you?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars.
