SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Byars. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, once again Senator Byars has not read his language. He said this bill does not segregate any group of students, or segregate any group of people. Let me ask Senator Byars a question before I go on, to see if that's really what he meant to say.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, would you respond to a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Byars, did you say that this bill does not segregate any group of people and discriminate against them?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I did, and I misspoke. You're absolutely correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, how did you misspeak? The bill does segregate.

SENATOR BYARS: Because it does not mandate every single student coming into the university system to be vaccinated. It does segregate a group of people who are living in on-campus housing. I misspoke.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So it does specify one group of students for treatment different from all the other students.

SENATOR BYARS: Correct. And the reason being, Senator, is because they're...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, I don't want to know the reason why...

SENATOR BYARS: ...seven times more at risk for living in that congregate housing than those who are living in an individual
