Again, it was clean-up language that strikes the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool because that wasn't the right term in defining limits, but it still does keep the health insurance provision. I know there was an e-mail circulated that this amendment struck the health insurance provision. That is not the case whatsoever, because it would still read that the individual would be required to carry proof of health insurance coverage. Thank you.
