SENATOR SMITH: ...mechanisms.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. Maybe you can find out more by tomorrow then. Thank you.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Can I move to adjourn until tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m.?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction) No. (Laughter)
