100 percent of the grandfather clause out, and I'll probably save my editorial comments for my designated time, but that's where we stand right now.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. Senator Beutler, would you want to take about 30 seconds and tell us about AM1215.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, the pending amendment strikes a particular subsection of the bill. And you may recall, we had a discussion yesterday with regard to an alternative exemption provision, and that was different from the standard exemption provision, that is exemptions from wearing the helmets, of course. And what I was striking was the alternative provision which had, in my opinion, two problems to it. First of all, it said that anybody born prior to January 1, 1984 was exempt from having to take the training course, so that all adults are exempt, basically, from having to take the training course in order to be exempt from wearing a helmet. The other thing that was wrong with it is that all adults included any persons of whatever age who were riding a motorcycle for the very first time, who had had no experience at all in riding a motorcycle, as opposed to, for example, other adults that this provision exempted who may have been riding a motorcycle for a period of time. So that's the worst aspect of the current language is that it doesn't require training for someone who has not ridden a motorcycle, provided they're an adult, they can be exempt from the helmet without any training. So that is, basically, what the amendment does, Senator Cudaback. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler, and, Senator Smith, for the review. We're now open for discussion on AM1215 offered by Senator Beutler to AM0159, which is the committee amendments to LB 303. Open for discussion on that amendment, Senator Smith, followed by Senator Beutler. Senator Smith.
