SENATOR SMITH: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right. Okay.

SENATOR SMITH: But that's been part of the discussion.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, okay.

SENATOR SMITH: And if you want to make DMV approve that, I'm amenable to that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Well, my thought was, I mean, if officers are going to go out there and check this, in reality they are going to have some kind of list of what's...or some way of monitoring it. So it seemed to me that it wouldn't be requiring anything more than what they should otherwise do to have them make a list of approved courses,...

SENATOR SMITH: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...or approved organizations to do the courses. Would that make sense?

SENATOR SMITH: I believe so.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Smith, you're recognized to speak.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you. I do want to point out on page 17, lines...starting in line 20, it does point out that the DMV shall establish minimum requirements for a motorcycle safety course. So the DMV is involved. If we want to add emphasis to that with this amendment, I'm not opposed to that. But, basically, the DMV shall establish those standards already. And a lot of the...a lot of the amendment is already accomplished with that. Thank you.
