SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. But if they are taking...but they could have taken some other test in accordance with the laws of some other state.

SENATOR SMITH: And if it met those requirements.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Or maybe some other state says you don't have to wear a helmet and you don't have to take a test, right?

SENATOR SMITH: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And if a person like that is riding...if a person from that state is riding a motorcycle in Nebraska, does he have to have his helmet on or off, or can he have it off?

SENATOR SMITH: He can have it off...

SENATOR BEUTLER: If he has an exemption (inaudible).

SENATOR SMITH: ...if he has taken a course or meets other exemptions in there.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So if he's going to ride the motorcycle in Nebraska, he has to meet Nebraska requirements?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So one of the Nebraska requirements would be a department approved course, right?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. So you're saying it is the intent of this bill that if you don't have my amendment, an out-of-state rider would still have to have taken the course approved by the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.
