SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Erdman. The house is under call. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. President, point of information. When I was recognized, does that...does the motion that Senator...or the request that Senator Chambers presented take precedence over me being recognized?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: He asked for a roll call vote.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: House is under call. Senator Quandahl, Senator Bromm, Senator Baker. Senator Baker, the house is under call. Senator Chambers, did you wish to wait for Senator Baker? The question before the body is ceasing debate on AM1198 to the committee amendments, AM0159, to LB 303. Been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll on ceasing debate.
