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make this perfectly clear. We don't want to shut down business. We don't want to make it so businesses can't call you. This is a business world. They have to have that opportunity and I want to stress that. That's not why I prioritized this bill, to stop or stifle business, no way. It's to help those that don't want to receive the call. It may even help businesses. They may want to know who doesn't want to hear me. If they know you're not going to buy something, why should they call Senator Chambers or Senator Cunningham or whatever? If they know you're not going to buy anything, just don't call me. This may help them. That's the way I'm looking at this here. I mean it's an issue that we know about and so I just said, hey, I'm going to go for this here; it helps all of us; even helps businesses. And so I'm leaving it in the hands of Senator Smith. He's worked out some arrangements with some people that had some questions about it, done a good job here and I think if we work together on this here, come up with something...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...that's workable, something that's workable, again, not that we're not trying to, you know, say you can't do this, can't do this, can't do this. That isn't what it's all about. Stop the ones that don't...I'm getting the finger here to sit down and be quiet, because they already know what this bill does. So anyway, I guess for...I meant that in a good way, whatever that means. But anyway, for now, I'm excited to bring this to you and let's see how it works out. Thank you. Senator Smith, did you want the rest of the time?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Senator Cudaback, you are the next speaker. I'm sorry, there are committee amendments. I'm sorry. Senator Baker, to open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Schimek and members. I thought, listening to Senator Smith's opening, he said something about this bill he's presenting was for some peace and quiet. Thought he was going to say on the floor, but then he qualified it saying in our houses, but either way it's a winner. I think this is a bill that there's been parts of it on the floor
