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SENATOR BAKER: Yup.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...since we are on the committee amendments, you've obviously studied this issue. I would assume that you would know it in-depth given that they're your amendments. Why are we duplicating the federal government's efforts in this arena?

SENATOR BAKER: We are not duplicating those efforts. There are many, many, many exceptions in the federal...proposed federal language that do not cover charitable groups, banks and so on, et cetera, and their definitions are a lot different than what we propose in the committee...

SENATOR BOURNE: But, Senator Baker, you've also heard me say that the Federal Communications Commission is going to establish a similar do-not-call list dealing with banking and insurance and those areas that are exempt from the...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Time.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...FTC's.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Mr. Clerk, are there other amendments?

CLERK: Madam President, first of all, I had a series of amendments from Senator Brashear, but he has asked that those be withdrawn. I had four different amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend. (FA1298, Legislative Journal pages 1204-1205.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Beutler, you are recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Schimek, members of the Legislature, my amendment goes to a particular section of the committee amendments and, by the way, I think the committee amendments are...the committee has done a lot of great work. I hope the
