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everyone that it...I mean it boils down to the fact that they would probably even pay more than \$3 to fund a program that will give them a little more peace and quiet in the evenings. Does that answer your question?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think so, Senator. I think what you're saying is that the bulk of the money would be from the \$3 fee,...

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...but then that would be supplemented by the fees from the solicitors also.

SENATOR SMITH: That's right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And I assume it's your intent that between the two it would be totally self funding.

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR SMITH: Yes, absolutely.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Baker...

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Did you indicate the time is up?

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes. Thank you, Senator Beutler...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...and Senator Smith. Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and I'll give some time to Senator Beutler if need be here if I can get through with what I want to say. Back to Senator Bourne's comments about why are we trying to dual track this with the federal government.
