to make sure that unsolicited faxes are also covered under this bill that we're working on. So, Senator Beutler, did 'ou have some questions? I would yield some time to you. Or is your light on next? I don't know. If he had a...okay, I'll continue. I just think it's very clear to us that we need this bill on the state level because of, the first place, we can control our own destiny here, and if we later want to merge this no-call list with what's on the federal level, we can do that at any time. That's not a problem. And...oh, I know what it was. The funding that Senator Beutler brought up, whether or not it's adequate, Public Service Commission has said they think that this is adequate. Of course, anything we do here we can come back and change. The \$3 fee, I was thinking it was for three years, maybe it's two years. I didn't find that in the committee amendments. But there's a \$3 fee to put your name on this. I am not sure where the upper limit would be for me as to how much I'd pay to get my name on a do-not-call list that would actually work. It'd be a lot more than \$3. So I don't think that's such a big issue that we can't go ahead and move the bill, and we may want to address that. But Public Service Commission seems to think we have adequate funding in there and, of course, as Senator Beutler pointed out, there are fees to access the list depending on the size. We did, in the committee amendments, make...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR BAKER: ...make a...or allot...there's a provision in the committee amendments to exempt legitimate nonprofit charitable organizations from that fee to access the list. So I think we've done a pretty good job in the committee amendments. We, I know, have spent a lot of time on this and I think, as I pointed out in opening on the committee amendments, there are parts of Senator Beutler's bill in here that was also heard in our committee. We think we've incorporated things together pretty doggone well. We may have to change some things because of what is happening on the federal level just on some penalty phases and so on, but I support...continue to...you know, I support the committee amendments, obviously, and I also support Senator Beutler's amendment. Thank you.
