SENATOR TYSON: They missed the change from ten to five.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. So this should read five years.

SENATOR TYSON: It should read five, yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. Then the other question I have, because we're talking about the Sheriffs' Association's opposition to the bill, deals with the part of the sheriff's fee. And on the fiscal note, I don't notice a comment from the counties or the sheriff. But is that fee adequate to cover their costs? I mean, is...

SENATOR TYSON: Cover the sheriff's costs?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR TYSON: The \$100 fee, Senator Thompson, is divided into two parts: \$50 to the...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR TYSON: ...state General Fund, and \$50 to the county. The money will go to the county treasurer, and it will not be assigned to the sheriff. But I made the point in discussing the bill that the sheriff and the county commissioners work together on budget in any event. And they work together, as far as I know, amiably, amicably. And if there is additional cost, he has \$50 going into the county general fund to draw on. But he'd have to get it via the county commissioners or county supervisors.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. But I guess my...I should state my question a little more clearly. We don't have...sometimes on fiscal notes we hear from other people who are impacted by a bill. And so the \$50 is not based on a study of...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.
