SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh. Very well. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: And that would be Senator Thompson.

SENATOR THOMPSON: I'll just use this time...I'm on the fiscal note issue. But I'll just do it now and get back to it on the bracket motion piece. Senator Tyson, I'd like to ask you a question. And if you have a copy of the amendment, I'm on page 7.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Pardon me. You're on page 7 of...I don't have that here.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Oh, okay. Well, what I'm...my question is about the renewal fee.

SENATOR TYSON: Fifty dollars.

SENATOR THOMPSON: The \$50.

SENATOR TYSON: Oh, now I have it. What page? Seven?

SENATOR THOMPSON: On page 7. "The sheriff may renew a person's permit to carry a concealed handgun for a renewal period of five years". And that's...

SENATOR TYSON: Yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...a \$50 deal.

SENATOR TYSON: Yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And then the sheriff collects the fee, and half goes to the treasurer in the county, and the other half goes to the State Treasurer. But I'm a little...I want to make sure I understand this. It says the renewal fee...this is "subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of section 6 of this act." And in Section 6, the Nebraska State
