Patrol conducts a criminal history record check to ensure the applicant's initial compliance. There's no criminal history record check the second time, for renewal?

SENATOR TYSON: The...if there had been a crime committed in the interim, Senator Thompson, it would have already been noted, and he would no longer have the permit. In other words, if you had your permit revoked, it's not...you can't go and get it a couple of years later for half price. It's gone.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So...

SENATOR TYSON: Yes. And you only get one bite at the apple.

SENATOR THOMPSON: All right. So what's the half going to the state for?

SENATOR TYSON: The renewal goes...

SENATOR TYSON: The renewal goes to the county.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...responsibility. If there's no...the sheriff has the responsibility to renew the permit?
