SENATOR TYSON: The state doesn't.

SENATOR THOMPSON: The...where does it state in your amendment that the sheriff doesn't have to split that? Because the next...after Section 2, Section 3 says the sheriff shall collect the fee. And half is deposited with the state, and half with the county. You know, I'm a former county commissioner, so I always kind of have to look out for those counties on these deals.

SENATOR TYSON: I would say that two should be three and three should be two...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR TYSON: ...in this.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. And then two should be clarified, that that...there is...if there's no further state function, that that...the whole \$50 goes to the county then.

SENATOR TYSON: That's implied but not stated.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. Senator Tyson, I'm willing to offer this amendment. Or, I don't know if this is something you would see as a cleanup here, but...

SENATOR TYSON: Well, not to broach a difficult subject, Senator Thompson, but if we're on your time, might as well use it. There are probably some things in here that I would like to see changed. But as long as Senator Chambers maintains the course of action that he has, I...and he has like 28 amendments filed now, I don't really see the possibility of that. So...

SENATOR THOMPSON: Well, thank you. Thank you, Senator Tyson.

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR THOMPSON: I think...oh, excuse me.
