April 10, 2003 LB 265A

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: (Visitor introduced.) There are no more lights on. Senator Tyson, you're recognized to close on the advancement of LB 265A.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Now we're back on something that we haven't talked much about in the last hour and a half. We're back on the A bill. The A bill that you have on your desk shows that this is a revenue-positive fiscal note. And while we have covered a lot of other subjects, it's probably a good idea, it's something we would not have to discuss on Select. This is a revenue-positive deal. I ask that people vote to support it. Mr. Speaker, I would ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote in regular order.

SPEAKER BROMM: A call of the house has been requested. Members, the question is, shall the house go under call? All in favor say aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please return to your seats and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Senators Engel and Schrock and Hartnett. Senator Engel and Senator Schrock, if you'd report to the Chamber, please. Senator Schrock. Senator Tyson, do you wish to wait for Senator Schrock? Go ahead? Okay. You asked for a roll call vote. Is that correct? Mr. Clerk, please call the roll. The question before us is the advancement of LB 265A to E & R Initial. Please call the roll.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1225.) The vote is 27 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 265A does advance. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record? I raise the call.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Thank you. Amendments to be
