site, say, if you want to register you can...with the federal, that's fine. We'll use it, transfer it back to the state for the intrastate calls that the federal government does not handle at all. That's another reason we really need something on the state level. The federal no-call list has nothing to do with intrastate calls. So we need to combine what they are doing with the federal...at the federal level. And I think we can see some efficiencies now. There's a private company...or, a public company has received a contract, as I understand, to build the federal no-call list. There's no reason why we have to dual track that. We can use it, transfer it back...it would appear, anyway, as of right now...transfer that back to the state, use that for our intrastate no-call list. There are some efficiencies here that I think we can do. And I think in fact Senator Smith is ahead of me on this. It is his bill, and he had some of these things, I think, in an amendment that will be incorporated into it. An additional amendment, I believe, is what we're going to do. We have visited with the lobby, to the point, I understand they wanted to back up and start from square zero with the green copy. I wasn't willing to do that. We need to adopt the committee amendments. And then we're going to take some things out, there's no question, change the fine schedule, things like that, the charitable organizations. I knew that was a problem. But I was not willing to back up to the green copy. We have worked it out, as I repeat. We need this on the state level, because that federal FTC and the FCC, although they say it's going to be there and it's going to be workable, we need to keep the pressure on the federal people as a state to get that done. We can probably piggyback off of the federal no-call list, transfer it back to the state level, the PSC, for the intrastate calls. And that's part of what we're going to work on between now and Select File, is what we can do with the fee that we had put in the bill, the \$3 fee to register your name, your phone number, for the three-year period. Whether we need to maintain that or whether they...actually we can use the federal no call list, and make sure that we educate the citizens of Nebraska that they can register with the federal no-call list, but it will be transferred back to the state level. So those are some of the things we're going to work on between now and Select File. I think we can get it done. I know we can get it done. They're good people. I have no problem working with
