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opportunity it would be to go to Disney World for some anniversary that they're having. And I guess when I'm interested in that, I know that I will be, and I'll call them. So nonetheless, there's a lot we can do as a state, without overreaching and without impeding Nebraska businesses. But I think we can adopt this and move forward, and the consumer will win out. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Smith. Senator Beutler, you are the next speaker.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Schimek, members of the Legislature, I feel a need to respond to Senator Bourne, since he said two of the people most interested in the bill were two of the most conservative people in the Legislature. And I assume he was referring to me. (Laughter) Senator Bourne, I want you to know that this is one of the most conservative...financially structured, this is one of the most conservative bills you could possibly have. Because not one single citizen pays a dollar unless they want to. And if they want to, they pay \$3, and they're on the list for three years. There is no General Funds, no General Funds, no General Funds. Sometimes I have a hard time thinking that Senator Bourne is talking about the same bill, because this is not imposing anything on anybody. It's allowing government to provide a service that nobody else can provide. The development of the no-call list at the federal level is something we should integrate and use in the best way possible. And we will do that with amendments before Select File. But you need to have a local bill. And the reason that you need to have a local bill is because even if you use the national list, it will apply to those things that the federal government says it applies to, but it won't apply to anything else unless there's a Nebraska bill that says, if you're on the federal list, you also don't make interstate calls, for example. You follow Nebraska law in Nebraska, if you're a telemarketer and you pick up a name on a national list and it's in Nebraska. That's what we want to have. So that we use the federal list...that's been suggested by the lobby; I think that's a good idea...but then you put into Nebraska law in this bill the things that we want it to apply to in Nebraska that may not be covered by federal law. So I think this can all be worked out
