that might have the effect of negating other laws that we have in this state. I just wanted to kind of get a sense of whether this is going to involve the changing of some of our laws, or this is pretty much supplemental to everything that we do now. And to the extent, I suppose, that there's some time left here, I would offer to, maybe starting with Senator Pedersen, the opportunity just to kind of comment on that section.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That will be about a minute and a half apiece, Senator Beutler, if you care to do that. Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. And thank you, Senator Beutler. If I remember right...and I didn't bring the testimony with me. But these questions were asked Mr. McCabe, and I think by Senator Chambers, when we had the hearing. There is no laws that, you know, it's going to affect us in any way seriously. We did not see any at the time that we had to worry about. And our basic concern was to make sure that we have...are able to have people flow freely back and forth between the states. I should be able to give you a more in-depth answer on that. I'm sorry I can't. But it's...we did not...were not able to uncover anything that was serious in that area.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you, Senator. Senator Brashear.

SENATOR CUDABACK: About a minute and a half, Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Beutler, as to all of your questions, the ease of exit is as you characterized it, from the compact. And that was a subject of inquiry at our hearing. The binding effect, specifically those questions were asked at the hearing, and there is no law known to us which has a problem under the compact. And while that seems coincidentally strange, I think we need to give it a frame of reference. We have been in a compact with all of these states since 1937 that had the same provision in it. It's that compact which is going away, ..
