been a long time, but if you can keep the motion down a little bit we'd appreciate it. Thank you. Record please, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1257.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 756 passes. Madam Clerk, LB 756A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 756A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 756A pass? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is LB 756A. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1257-1258.)
43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 756A passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 148.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on the desk. Senator Landis would move to return LB 148 to Select File for specific amendment AM1197. (Legislative Journal page 1197.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: (Visitors introduced.) Senator Friend, I understand that you are authorized to handle the Landis motion. You may open.

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, we, looking at AM1197, pointed out some technical difficulties with a particular line and we... Senator Landis, on behalf of Senator Landis, would like to request the amendment be placed... moved back to... the bill moved back to Select File and placed in Select File. Specifically, on page 10, what it would essentially do, it's a technical amendment again, strike the beginning with "the" in line 7 through "not" in line 8, and insert "nor the child and one parent, nor the child and a person acting as a parent." Again, this is a technical amendment. The Bill Drafters pointed out a technical deficiency, if you will.
