SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR PREISTER: ...one more opportunity to raise questions? Final Reading shouldn't be just a blanket vote and be done with it and not consider the consequences of those votes and the action that's to follow, because this could be potentially extremely expensive for the people of Nebraska. This amendment doesn't take away the ability to enter the agreement. It doesn't. It may slow the process down for two weeks, but I don't think it would even have an impact. It simply says we want to limit the exposure to some of the liability. I would ask you to please return the bill to Select File for that specific amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Preister. You've heard the closing. The question before us is whether or not LB 165 shall be returned to Select File. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is not successful. Mr. Clerk. We'll read LB 165.

CLERK: (Read LB 165 on Pinal Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 165 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1259.) 29 ayes, 10 nays, 5 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 165 fails to pass with the emergency clause attached, not having received the required number of votes. We
