April 14, 2003 LB 461, 498

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Dwite Pedersen, to open on advancement of LB 498 to E & R Initial.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This bill provides a new class of license through the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board for a dealer's agent. A dealer's agent would be able to act as a buying agent for multiple motor vehicle dealers. The Licensing Board would be required to have written contracts between dealers and agents on file, and the dealer's agent would have to disclose all dealers for whom they are authorized to buy vehicles for. The bill was heard by the Transportation Committee on February 18. It was sent to the General File with all members of the committee voting for it. I urge you to send this bill on to Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Open for discussion on the advancement of LB 498. Seeing no senators wishing to speak, Senator Pedersen. He waives the opportunity to close on the advancement. The question before the body is, shall LB 498 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye; opposed nay. The question before the body is to advance LB 498 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 498.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 498 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: LB 461, by Senator Janssen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16, referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Janssen, you're recognized to open on advancement of LB 461.
