SENATOR CUDABACK: Are you through, Senator Schimek? Next speaker would be Senator Schimek. Senator Schimek waives the opportunity. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Just a few minutes. Senator Schimek, could I ask you a question?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, would you answer?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Did I hear you say that the county supervisors don't have to live in the district that they represent?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That the...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...supervisors need not be a resident of the district from which they are filing...for which they are filing for election.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's the way it is now?
