they are judged and adjudicated accordingly with what the law has in place right now. But they are asking for this second chance. They are asking for it, at the same time fully realizing if they mess up they go to jail. Now, I don't think that's a harsh penalty. That is a second chance. Give the rest of my time back to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Aguilar. Senator Chambers, followed by Senators Cunningham and Hartnett. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Aguilar is beginning to mix up concepts in the legal system. When Senator Beutler talked about an interlocal agreement, Senator Aguilar tried to rebut what Senator Beutler said by suggesting that you must have an interlocal agreement because of probation. Yet this is not supposed to be probation. If this is probation, we don't need a drug court. If this is probation, the judge can say, as a condition of probation, you shall take drug counseling, you shall abstain from the use of drugs, and everything that's in this bill. So if it's probation we're talking about, you don't need this at all. There is a rogue judge out there who has gotten Senator Aguilar on a hobby horse. And I want to ask Senator Aguilar a question, because he asked that I do so. Senator Aguilar, understanding the question I would ask you if I knew what it was you wanted me to ask you, presume that I've asked it, state the question, and then offer the answer to us.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator Aguilar?

SENATOR AGUILAR: Question, Senator Chambers. The answer to that question is, probation is involved here simply because some of the drug courts choose to use some of the probation officers as supervisors and testing personnel.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But are you aware, Senator, that whether...regardless of whom may be used, that does not turn something into probation if it is not probation. If a judge does not enter an order of probation, there is no probation created otherwise. Are you aware of that?
